## **Updates from the Township of Ocean Library**

(1) Movies...Movies -- Interested in enjoying a good movie? Then look no further than our library, where a number of movies are being shown this month. All the movies are free to attend!

**July 6, 2023 at 2:00 p.m.** -- **Dear Evan Hansen --** Is a coming-of-age musical about seventeen-year-old Evan Hansen, a high school senior who suffers from social anxiety and depression, and his journey of self discovery after a classmate's suicide. Stars Ben Platt (reprising the role he played on Broadway), Kaitlyn Dever, Nik Dodani, Julianne Moore and Amy Adams. (2021) (Rated PG-13)

July 13, 2023 at 2:00 p.m. -- Julie and Julia -- This film contrasts the life of chef Julia Child in the early years of her career with the life of young New Yorker Julie Powell, who aspires to cook all 524 recipes in Child's cookbook in 365 days. Stars Meryl Streep, Amy Adams, Stanley Tucci, and Chris Messina. (2009) (Rated PG-13)

July 20, 2023 at 2:00 p.m. -- High Note -- A superstar singer and her overworked personal assistant are presented with a choice that could alter the course of their respective careers. In its opening weekend, this film was the second most rented film on Fandango Now, third most from the iTunes Store, and 11th most on Amazon Prime Video. Stars Dakota Johnson, Tracee Ellis Ross, Kelvin Harrison, Jr. and Ice Cube. (2020) (Rated PG-13)

**July 27, 2023 at 2:00 p.m.** -- **Lion --** An Australian biographical drama based on the 2013 non-fiction book "A Long Way Home" by Saroo Brierley. It tells the true story of how Brierley, 25 years after being separated from his family in India, sets out to find them. Stars Dev Patel, Rooney Mara, David Wenham, and Nicole Kidman. (2016) (Rated PG-13)

(1) Did you know that our library offers a large selection of DVDs that you can take home to view? In fact, our branch boasts a whole section of the latest movies, hit TV shows, and more. As you enter the library, you'll find the DVDs in the adult book area near the circulation desk. So, stop by the library and then break out the popcorn when you get home. And, if you need help with the DVDs, please ask one of our wonderful library staff members -- they will be happy to assist you.



**Happening Around Town** 

- (1) July 4th Celebration -- Grab your coolers and lawn chairs and come picnic in Joe Palaia Park on Saturday July 1, 2023 from 6:00 p.m. 11:00 p.m. as our town celebrates our country's Independence Day. There will be music, children's activities, and food trucks. You won't want to miss the fun and the fireworks (which will go off at dark).
- (2) New Complaint Portal Launched -- Experiencing a problem in town? Take note that our town has created a new complaint system which permits you to submit your concerns for attention. Simply to to our town's website at: <a href="www.oceantwp.org">www.oceantwp.org</a> and click on the new complaint portal (located under "news" in the center of the home page).

You'll be asked to select to whom you are directing the problem (our town manager or the police), the type/nature of the complaint, and its location. You also will need to provide your name and contact information so that the town can both contact you if there are questions about your submission and alert you to the issue's resolution.

- (3) Wood Smoke -- With the growing popularity of outdoor wood burning stoves and fire pits and the recent air quality issues we experienced due to the Canadian wildfires, our town is reminding residents that while wood smoke may smell good, it's not good for your health -- especially if you have heart or lung disease, are older, or are pregnant. But, there are four easy ways to reduce harmful wood smoke:
  - Use a cleaner heating device like a heat pump, gas stove or EPAcertified wood pellet stove.
  - Burn only dry, seasoned wood for a hotter fire and less smoke.
  - Test your wood with a wood moisture meter (20% moisture or less burns best).
  - Provide sufficient air to the fire; never let it smolder.

But, then another American couple arrives raising Kate's suspicions that they aren't who they say they are and causing her to fear that her past is about to catch up with her. (Please
